



Code of Conduct (based on RSEQ)

Participant's Code

- ❖ I respect the rules of the game.
- ❖ I accept all decisions made by the referee.
- ❖ I honestly support my teammates.
- ❖ I refuse to win by illegal means and/or by cheating.
- ❖ I accept the mistakes of my teammates.
- ❖ I consider my opponent as essential to the game.
- ❖ I am courteous to coaches, officials, spectators and opponents.
- ❖ I provide a constant and committed effort.
- ❖ I accept victory with humility without ridiculing the opponent.
- ❖ I accept defeat being satisfied with the efforts made within the limits of my abilities and recognizing the good work of the opponent.
- ❖ I play for the pleasure of playing.
- ❖ I consider victory or defeat as a consequence of the pleasure of playing.
- ❖ I consider personal achievement more important than getting a medal or a trophy.
- ❖ I first introduce myself as a human being.
- ❖ I also represent my team, my school and my community.
- ❖ I embody my sport's values by each of my behaviour.
- ❖ I am an ambassador of the NIBG.

Spectator's Code

- ❖ I believe that athletes play sports for their own pleasure and not to entertain me.
- ❖ I don't have unrealistic expectations. I am aware that the participants are not professional athletes and should not be judged by the standards applied to professionals.
- ❖ I consider each athlete with respect.
- ❖ I respect all the decisions of the referees and encourage participants to do the same.
- ❖ I never ridicule an athlete who committed an error during a competition. I rather make positive comments to motivate and encourage continued effort.
- ❖ I consider victory or defeat as a consequence of the pleasure of playing.
- ❖ I respect all athletes, coaches and the opposing teams.
- ❖ I acknowledge with dignity the performance of the defeated opponent.
- ❖ I accept victory with humility without ridiculing the opponent.

- ❖ I condemn the use of violence in all its forms and I let it known to the coaches and officials.
- ❖ I avoid using improper language or harassing athletes, coaches, officials or other spectators.
- ❖ I encourage all participants in a civilized manner.
- ❖ I am a privileged witness of the NIBG2017.

Coach's Code

- ❖ I consider each athlete with respect and fairness, regardless of gender, race, physical skills, economic status or any other condition.
- ❖ I always act in the best interest of the athletes.
- ❖ I consider individual development more important than sports.
- ❖ I prefer the academic success of athletes within sporting goals.
- ❖ I know and respect the written and unwritten rules in my sport.
- ❖ I respect all the decisions of the referees.
- ❖ I consider victory or defeat as a consequence of the pleasure of playing.
- ❖ I respect all athletes, coaches and fans of other teams.
- ❖ I acknowledge with dignity the performance of the defeated opponent.
- ❖ I accept victory with humility without ridiculing the opponent.
- ❖ I am honest with all athletes and the sport.
- ❖ I honour my commitments whether they be written or verbal, with athletes and the institution.
- ❖ I refuse to win by illegal means or by cheating.
- ❖ I show courtesy, openness and respect for my colleagues.
- ❖ I make sure that the equipment and sports facilities meet the level of athlete development and safety principles.
- ❖ I inform athletes of the dangers inherent in the practice of our sport.
- ❖ I inform athletes of the dangers of alcohol and drugs.
- ❖ I contribute to the advancement of the profession by sharing my knowledge and my experience with my colleagues and students.
- ❖ I use precise language without insults or vulgar expressions.
- ❖ I respect my power as a coach by preserving the physical and mental health of athletes.
- ❖ I embody the importance of always being in good physical condition.
- ❖ I protect an image reflecting the positive values of my sport and of the coach.

General Rules

Respect

- ❖ Any form of violence, intimidation and vandalism are not tolerated. Appropriate and polite language must be used at all times and in all places;
- ❖ Respect is expected in all relations: between NIBG2017 volunteers, chaperones, officials, leaders in charge and all participants.

The Cleanliness of the Site

- ❖ Keep ALL areas clean at all times: competition site, accommodation centres, changing rooms, washrooms and cafeteria;
- ❖ Do not litter. Trash must be put in the garbage. If a garbage can is full, use another garbage;
- ❖ You will be provided with garbage bags on the opening day, at the registration. No trash should be found on the floor or in the accommodation centers during the entire time of your stay.
- ❖ Places to drop your trash (during games, competitions and your used garbage bags) will be at your disposal.
- ❖ Leaders in charge and chaperones must repeat to their participants to put their trash in the garbage cans at all times: after eating snacks and meals, in the bleachers and on competition sites.
- ❖ ALL areas, including washrooms and showers, must stay clean at all times.

Leaders and Chaperones

- ❖ The leaders and chaperones of each community must ensure that their entire delegation adopts acceptable behaviour and that there is no squabble either inside or outside the infrastructure;
- ❖ The leaders and chaperones are bound by a general and permanent obligation of supervision, prudence and security towards the participants in their care, 24 hours a day (from arrival to departure of delegations).

Smoking, Food and Beverage Consumption

- ❖ Alcohol and drug use is prohibited at all times. Any person found using either alcohol and/or drugs will be expelled immediately and won't be able to participate in the NIBG2017 for the following days.
- ❖ For safety reasons, energy drinks consumption is not tolerated during competitions hours (Monster, Redbull, etc.).
- ❖ All food wrappers must be thrown in the garbage. It is forbidden to eat or drink inside all sports installations, except for the bleachers.
- ❖ Water is indispensable for all participants' health and safety. It is the only beverage that is tolerated everywhere.

- ❖ Tobacco consumption is authorized only in designed areas. If someone is found smoking outside those zones, their delegation will receive a sanction.

Sports Equipment Lending Service

- ❖ Some sports equipment will be at your disposal. It is your responsibility to bring it back after each use.
- ❖ Any unreturned item will be billed to you at the end of your stay.

Security

- ❖ Security inside accommodation centres and competitions sites is the responsibility of the security department of Wemotaci NIBG2017.
- ❖ In case of accidents or problems, someone from the security department will analyze the situation and make a final decision with NIBG2017 of Wemotaci project manager.

Each community is completely responsible for their delegation's actions and behaviours. They also commit to refund any costs related to incidents caused by their delegation.
